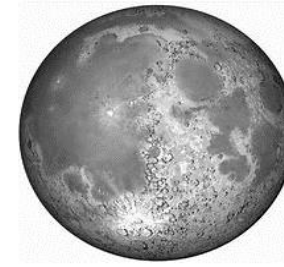


Resident of the Month
